POST SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS - 2010
JOHN LENNIE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP &
JAKE ISBISTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Education Fund of Local 1005, U.S.W. is offering one (1) award of \$5,000.00 for the John Lennie Scholarship and three (3) \$1,005.00 awards for the Jake Isbister Scholarship to students, in Ontario.

The conditions of these scholarships are: a) previous winners are not eligible b) the scholarships shall be awarded only to sons and daughters of members, of Local 1005, United Steelworkers.

Recipients of scholarships must be prepared to show their level of education is sufficient to allow admittance to an approved institution of higher education, such as university, technological institute, teacher's college, nursing school, etc.

- C) Worker Elected Politicians**
↪ *How to get workers involved and elected in Federal, Provincial and Municipal elections.*

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FOLLOWING;
(NO EXCEPTIONS)**

- 2. Your academic records (Transcripts).**
- 3. A letter of reference from your Principal or from the appropriate personnel from the attending University or College.**
- 4. The 2,000 (John Lennie Scholarship) or 1,000 (Jake Isbister Scholarship) essay.**
